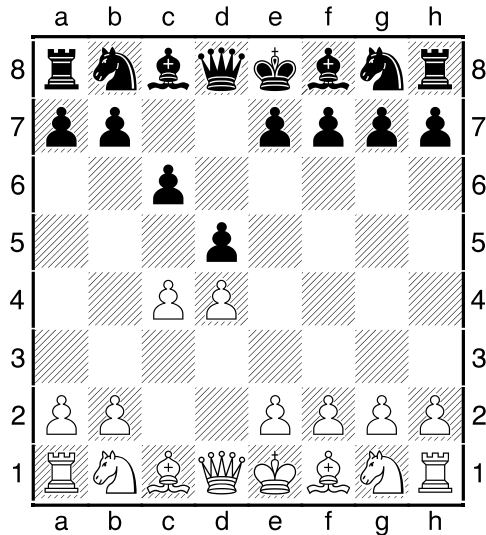

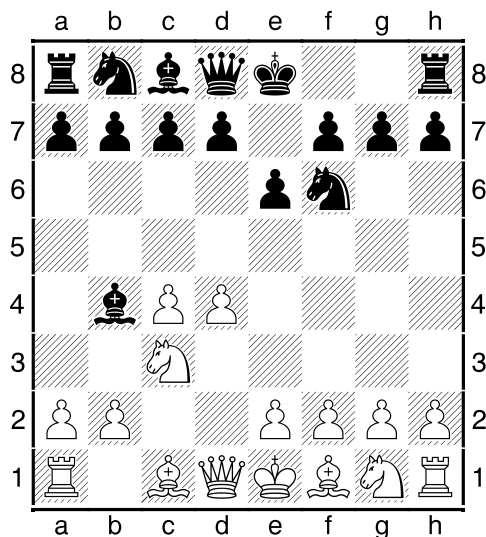

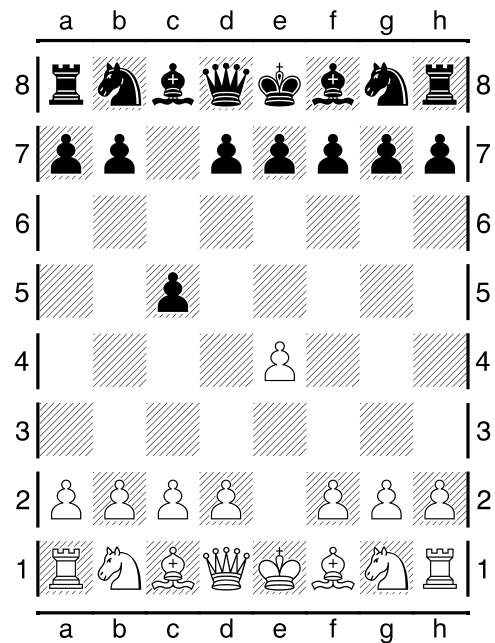

The Best by Test

The Sicilian is the most popular and best-scoring response to White's first move 1.e4. Statistical surveys shows that 1.d4 is the most successful first move for White, but only because 1...c5 scores so highly against 1.e4.
